LIMC ELECTS 2012 COMMITTEE OFFICERS

Lancaster, Pennsylvania, December 15, 2011—The Lancaster Inter-Municipal Committee (LIMC) elected the committee's 2012 officers at the regular monthly meeting held in Columbia, Pennsylvania. Kathy Wasong, a Lancaster Township supervisor, was elected chairperson. John Bingham, an East Hempfield Township supervisor, was elected vice chairperson. Kent Gardner, a West Hempfield Township supervisor, was elected secretary-treasurer.

The new officers will lead the continued efforts of the LIMC in finding regional solutions for common problems encountered by the member municipalities. Several of these efforts include regional stormwater management initiatives, partnerships with higher education entities, and implementation of the regional comprehensive plan.

Kent Gardner is no stranger to the LIMC's pursuits and achievements. He has led the organization the past two years as the chairperson. He felt it was time to move aside and concentrate on specific goals and initiatives. The committee felt otherwise. Mr. Gardner's selection as the 2012 secretary-treasurer will keep him a key figure within the LIMC.

Kathy Wasong has been the vice chairperson for the past two years and an active member of the LIMC, Lancaster County Planning Commission, and Lancaster Township. She looks to continue her efforts in furthering the abilities of the LIMC to help the community and member municipalities as the chairperson.

John Bingham was recently reelected to the East Hempfield Township Board of Supervisors. His reelection allows a continued presence and voice within the LIMC organization. Mr. Bingham is also the chairperson of the Lancaster County Clean Water Consortium, a key partner of the LIMC.

After the election, the committee expressed sincere gratitude to the outgoing secretary-treasurer Pat Coller, a member of the Lancaster City Council. Ms. Coller was an integral part in the successes of both the LIMC and the City of Lancaster. Ms. Coller did not seek reelection for the city council.

The LIMC is a council of governments located in central Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. LIMC members include the City of Lancaster; Boroughs of Columbia, East Petersburg, Millersville, and Mountville; and the Townships of East Hempfield, East Lampeter, Lancaster, Manheim, Manor, West Hempfield, and West Lampeter.
